

Printable Safety Checklist

Please use your own discretion when safeguarding your home.

Kitchen

- Store cleaners in a locked and/or high cabinet.
- Keep oven and dishwasher handles free of dishcloths and rags.
- Install cabinet locks.
- Install an oven door lock.
- Store appliances that are sharp like blenders and food processors out of reach.

Bathroom

- Keep cleaners, chemicals and all medicine (including vitamins) in a locked cabinet.
- Secure toilet lids.
- Store items like curling irons, hair dryers, and flat irons in a locked or high cabinet.
- Install door knob covers to help prevent access to the bathroom.

General Safety

- Install safety gates at the top and bottom of the stairs.
- Have car seats checked to make sure they are installed properly.
- Keep doors closed and restrict access to rooms that are not child friendly.

Living Areas

- Hide wires behind furniture or use a wire hider.
- Cover outlets.
- Use safety gates restricting access to stairways.
- Install sliding door locks.
- Secure televisions and heavy furniture like bookcases to the wall.
- Cover sharp corners and edges with guards and bumpers.

Bedroom

- Keep mini blind cords separated/out of reach.
- Secure furniture to the wall.
- Cover outlets with outlet protectors or furniture.
- Install bed rails.

Remember, the best tip for safeguarding your home is adult supervision!
